Necessity required the modification of existing Ennis-style upwelling incubators to successfully incubate twice the usual amount of eggs utilizing the same amount of water flow. Incubators designed to hold up to 12 kg of eggs were modified to hold up to 27 kg of eggs using approximately the same amount of water, 18 liters per minute. The presentation will describe the upwellers and the modifications made.
