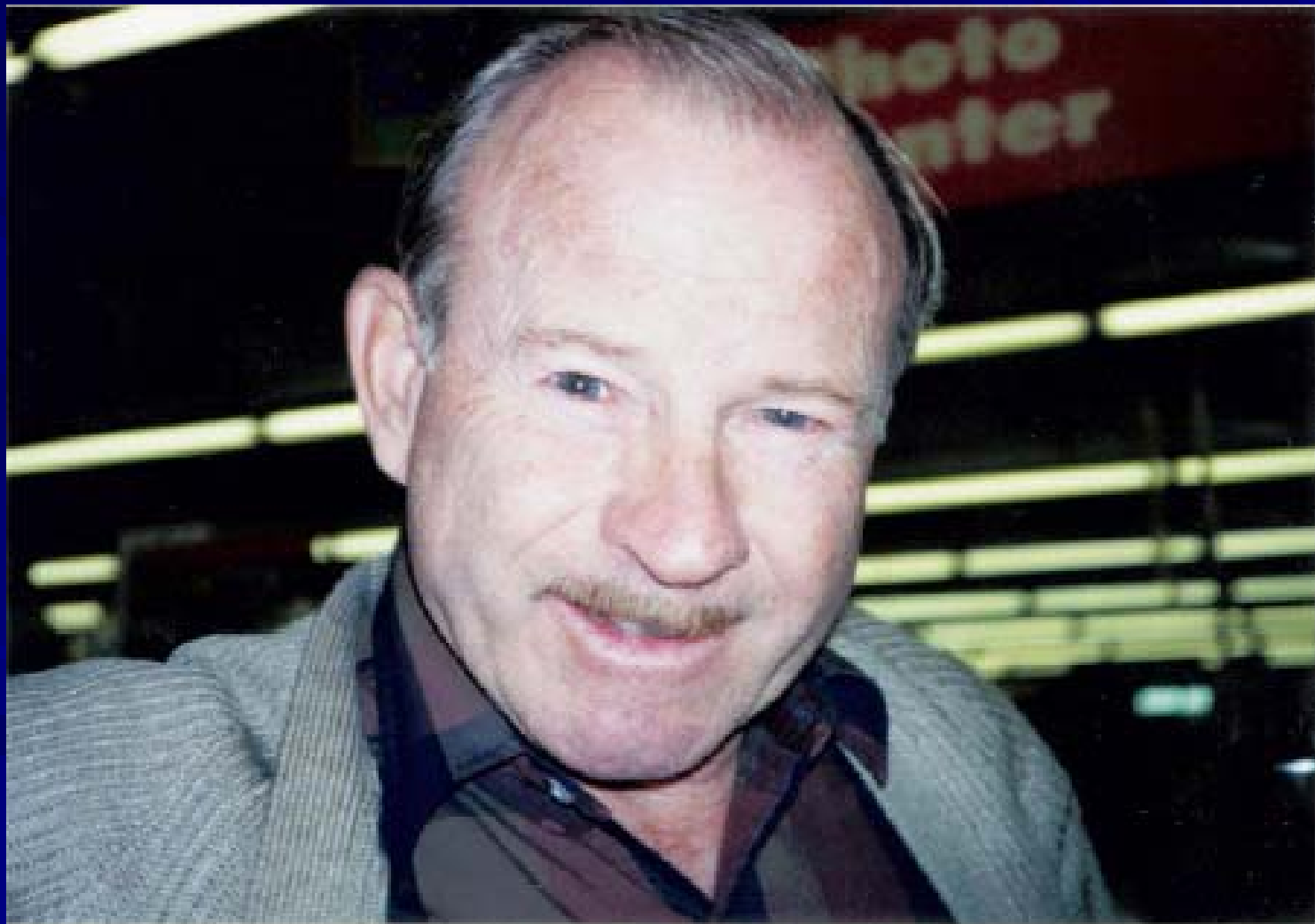


Bruce G. Barngrover

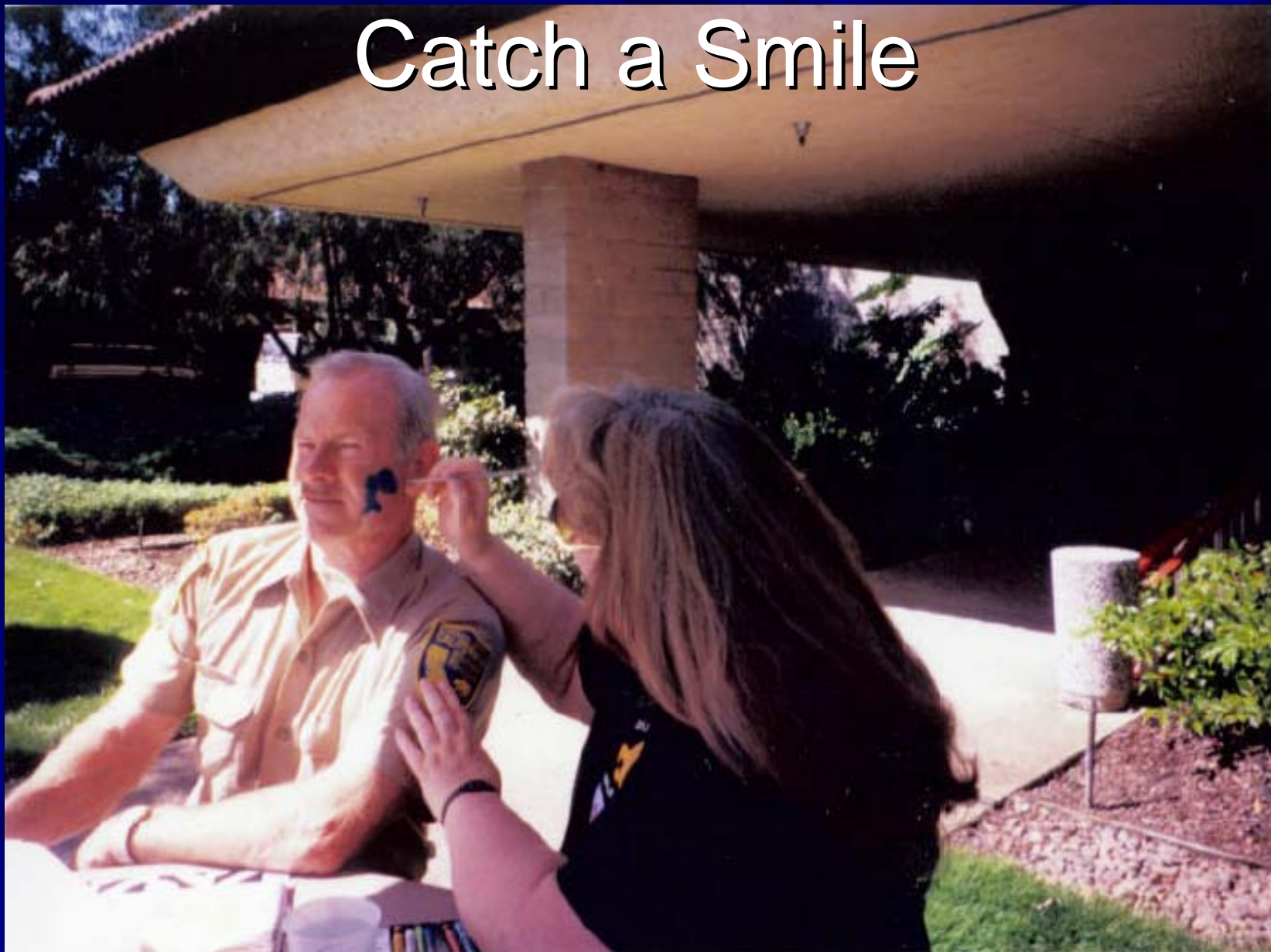
