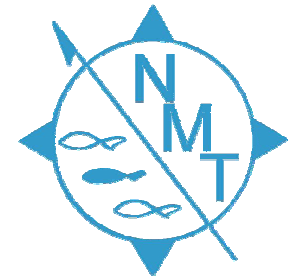


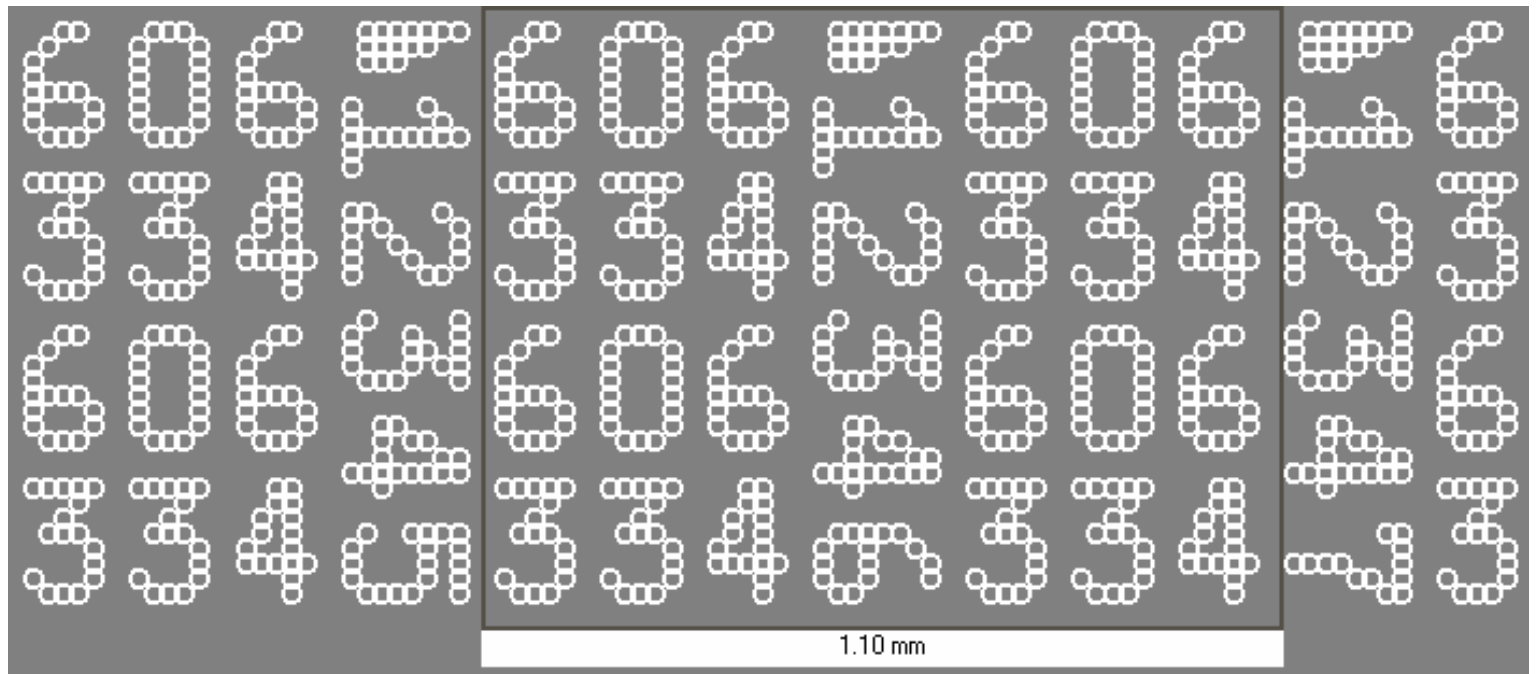

- SeqCWT have a batch code plus an individual code.
- Standard length only.

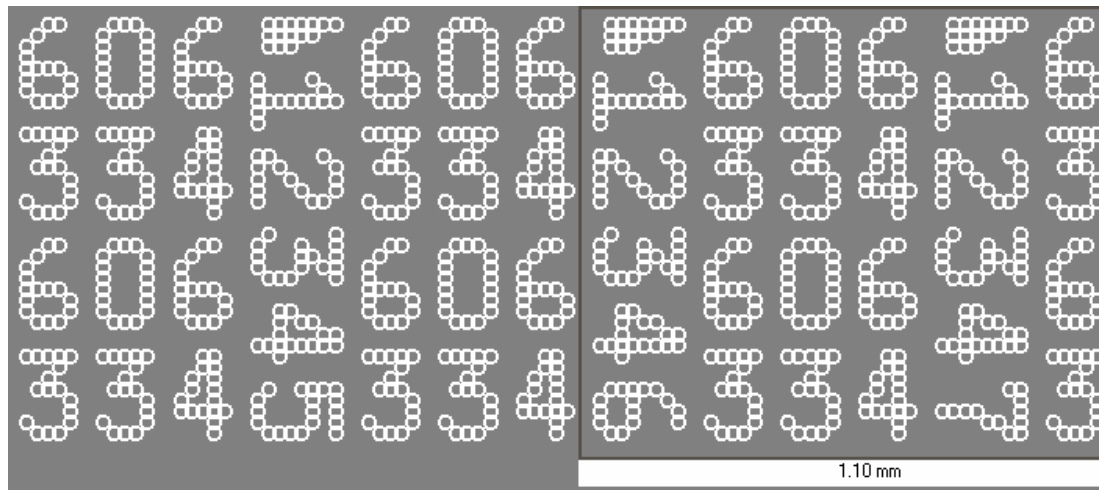
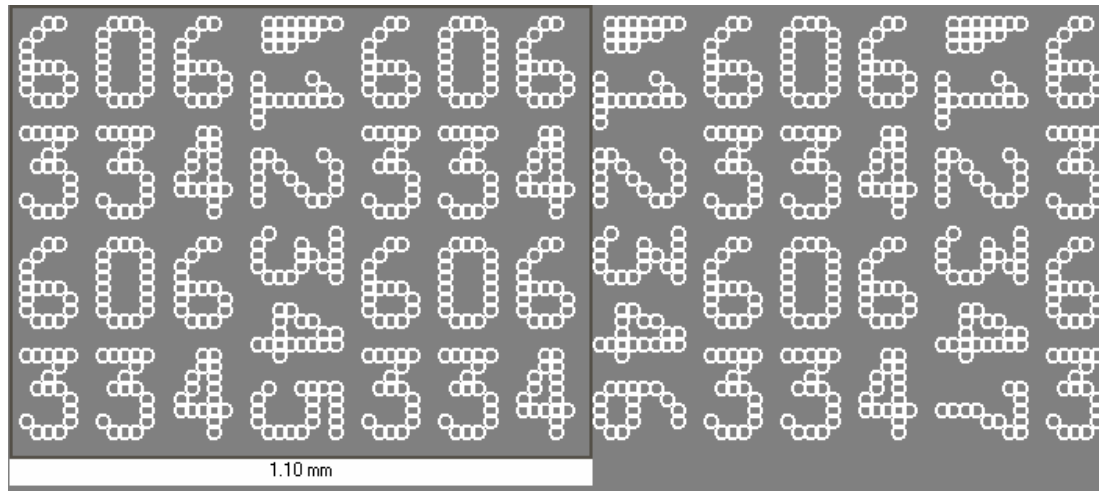




How do you use SeqCWT?

- Redundant formatting means that the tags are not cut consistently with one individual coding sequence per tag.
- Tags in between groups must be archived so that the tag code and specimen can be related at recovery.
- Identify groups as small as one, but it has great value for small tag groups when the number per group isn't known in advance.

 - Need unrolled records.
