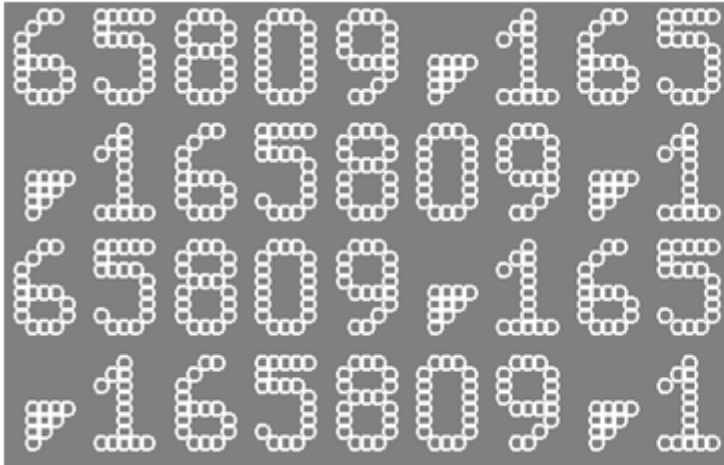


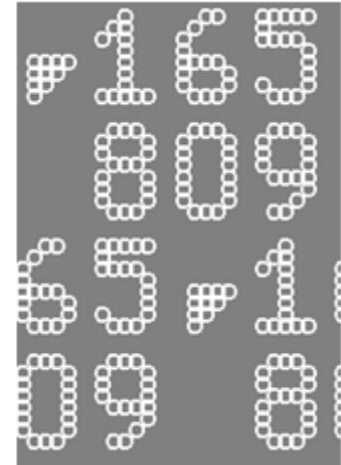

# What did we do?

- As of January 2016,
  - NMT will no longer make tags in this subset.
  - Removing the tag type as a requirement of uniqueness collapses the code space
- But, we have history... so
- We created a “Combined Code Usage Chart”
  - Assess and communicate code collision issues
  - Available on request

- Bottom line: research is required, give us a call

# Enhanced Data Sharing - Agencies

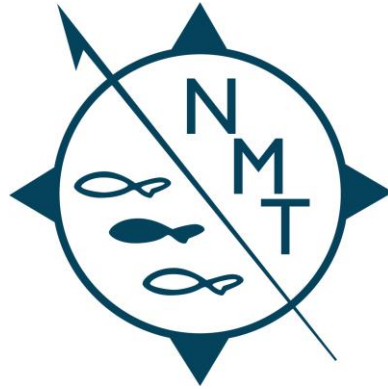
- ✓ Tag coordinator can request production records and usage charts for their agency
- ✓ Tag coordinator can request monthly report of shipments
- ✓ Inquiries from other sources will be directed to the proper coordinator or the RMPC
