Hi Jim and Dan,

With several recent retirements I am busier on many fronts and need to take a pass on the upcoming virtual meeting. Here are approximate Yakama Nation Planned 2021 releases:

Yakima Basin

Spring Chinook: ~550,400 total release (89% CWT in snout, 11% CWT in post-dorsal)

Fall Chinook:  
released from Prosser, approximately 1.6m subyearlings (LWS NFH transfers) and 210,000 yearlings (Bonneville Hatchery transfers)  
Prosser URBs released from Prosser, ~430,000, 20% PIT, no CWT

Summer Chinook: ~500,000 Wells stock subyearlings released from Yakima R. acclimation sites, 100% CWT

Sockeye: natural-origin progeny of adult plants; minimal marking (PIT) at downstream juvenile sampling stations

Coho: ~0.5million total release from Prosser and about 700,000 release from Melvin Sampson facility near Ellensburg, ~63% CWT- all blank wire tag

Mid-Columbia Coho: ~1.8million total release, 100% CWT (of which about 22% blank wire tag)

Klickitat Basin

Spring Chinook: ~114,600 total release, ~25% CWT  
Fall Chinook: ~4.3m total release, ~15% CWT

Coho:  
Lewis stock released from Klick. Hatchery, ~1.2m, ~5% CWT  
Washougal stock direct released in lower Klick. R., ~1.5m
