

## IDFG production plans and marking/tagging for 2022

**Mass Marking** - With the exception of some limited releases intended for supplementation or specific broodstock management purposes, most spring/summer chinook salmon (94%) and steelhead (85%) are mass marked with an adipose fin clip (see tables below).

**Mark Selective Fisheries**- Recreational fisheries for Chinook salmon and steelhead in Idaho are mark selective. Tribal fisheries in Idaho are non-selective.
